Homeless Services and Student's Rights

** If your family is homeless, you have the right to choose to enroll your child(ren) in the school last attended if feasible or the school serving the area where you are staying now. The homeless case manager can assist your family if you wish to keep your student(s) in the school last attended.

Homeless students are eligible for transportation to and from school if needed. If the student's temporary address is outside the enrolling school's regular attendance area, and if it is determined that continued attendance at that school is in the student's best interest, transportation will be made available. Contact the homeless case manager to make arrangements as needed. If it is feasible for the student to continue to attend your school once he or she becomes housed during the school year, transportation is the responsibility of the family or at the discretion of the school district.

Grant-Funded services available for homeless students and their families include:

- * Funds to purchase birth certificates
- * Funds for activity and field trip fees
- * Funds to replace textbooks, library books, and for book fairs
- * Scholarships for participation in early childhood programs
- * Transportation for students who are not able to use our busses
- * Transportation for families to attend conferences and school events
- * Tutoring to help students catch up and stay current
- * School supplies, backpacks, school clothes and other daily living and enrichment items
- * Case management and support services
